Terms and Conditions - 2025/26

The Terms and Conditions laid out below are applicable to any and all advance group bookings for the Shakespeare Birthplace Trust (SBT). This includes, but is not limited to:

- Visits to the Shakespeare family homes and gardens
- Online ticketed events.

Please note: once your visit is booked and confirmed to you by email, it is fully subject to these terms and conditions.

Bookings

1. There are a limited number of tickets available in pre-designated time slots for each site/visit date. If your chosen timeslot is booked up, you will be offered the next available slot.
2. All bookings for visits to any of the Shakespeare family homes and gardens must be booked, confirmed and paid for in advance of the visit date.
3. Bookings must be made by email in the first instance and followed by a phone call if necessary. We will confirm the booking/s by email. This will also serve as the invoice for the visit.
4. Bookings can be made up to a year in advance of the visit but must be reconfirmed and all details of the booking finalised **no later than 7 days (one week) before the visit date**.
5. If any changes or cancellations need to be made to your booking, you must notify us by email before the 7-day deadline. If you inform us of any reduction in numbers or cancellations after this date you will not be refunded any payment that has been made as the allocation for the visit has already been confirmed.
6. Please note: the cost of the visit will be based on final confirmed numbers.
7. Please note: we reserve the right to ask groups to leave if their behaviour on site is deemed to be unacceptable and disrespectful to other visitors.

Payment

1. Payment must be made by the due date using one of the payment methods specified on the booking confirmation/invoice.
2. We reserve the right to charge interest in accordance with The Late Payment of Commercial Debts (interest) Act 1998 and therefore any payments received after the specified payment date are subject to these additional interest fees.
3. In the unlikely event that your payment is late, you will be contacted by our finance team and no further bookings will be made for you, your school or organisation until any outstanding invoices are settled and paid.
4. We retain the right to cancel, or refuse entry, if payment is not made on time.

5. The gardens, site exhibitions and elements of the visitor offer are subject to last minute changes. The Shakespeare Birthplace Trust therefore reserves the right to cancel bookings at any time but will endeavour to give as much notice as possible should this occur.
6. If this does happen, the Shakespeare Birthplace Trust is only responsible for issuing a refund for the booking payment. Any other costs incurred around your visit are at your own risk.
7. We regret that no refunds can be given for cancellations or changes to bookings made by the booker less than 7 days in advance of your visit. This includes non-arrivals on the day of the visit itself.
8. The Shakespeare Birthplace Trust also retains the right to adjust prices during this period should circumstances dictate.
